



Halloween Pumpkin Amigurumi

iogurumi handmade

Supplies

- 1,75 mm crochet hook
- sewing and tapestry needle
- cotton yarn n. 5 (orange and brown)
- fiberfill for stuffing
- black felt
- glue

Abbreviations

- mr: magic ring
- ch: chain
- slst: slip stitch
- sc: single crochet
- hdc: half double crochet
- blo: work in back loop only

Tips

- The pumpkin is crocheted in rows.
- The stalk is crocheted in rounds: work it in a continuous spiral, without joining rounds.
- All stitches are worked in to both loops, unless instructed otherwise in the pattern.

Gauge

It isn't necessary to use the recommended yarn and crochet hook. You can use a larger or smaller crochet hook and a suitable yarn, to obtain a larger or smaller pumpkin preserving the same proportions. If you use the cotton yarn and the crochet hook recommended in this pattern, the pumpkin will be about 7 cm large and 5 cm tall.



Pumpkin

With **orange** cotton yarn:

1: ch 22

2: in blo, work sc 4, hdc 13, sc 4, ch 1, turn (21)

3 - 30: repeat row 2

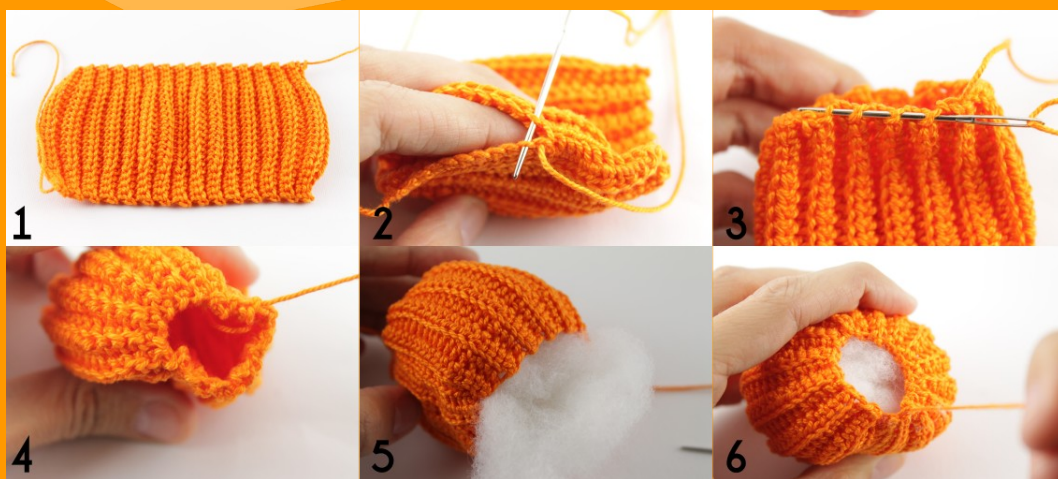
Cut the yarn, leaving a long yarn tail for sewing, and fasten off (picture 1).

Sew row 30 to row 1 (picture 2).

Sew the tail through loops along the top opening (picture 3) and pull to gather closed (picture 4).

Stuff and bring the tail to the bottom opening (picture 5).

Sew the tail through loops along the bottom opening and pull to gather closed (picture 6).



Stalk

With **brown** cotton yarn:

1: mr, sc 5

2-4: sc 5 (5)

5: (slst, sc, hdc, sc, slst) x 5 (25)



Eyes, nose, mouth

Cut eyes, nose and mouth from a piece of black felt.

Assembly

Sew the stalk to the pumpkin and glue eyes, nose and mouth.
